

SIRDAR

Easy
Knit

ALPINE

One Size

2 BALL SNOOD in SIRDAR ALPINE

MEASUREMENTS

Snood width and length approximately	18 x 92	cm
	7 x 36¼	in

MATERIALS

Snood		
F227 Alpine shade 402	2	50g balls

The yarn amounts are based on average requirements when specified tension and yarn is used. You will also need 1 Pair of 10mm (UK000 – USA15) Knitting Needles for the Snood.

TENSION

17 sts and 24 rows to 20cm, (8in) on 10mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension. Check your tension – if less stitches use a thinner needle, if more use a thicker needle.

ABBREVIATIONS

alt alternate, **cm** centimetres, **cont** continue, **g** grammes, **in** inch(es), **k** knit, **mm** millimetres, **p** purl, **rem** remain(ing), **rs** right side, **st(s)** stitch(es), **tog** together, **ws** wrong side.

SNOOD

Using 10mm needles and thumb method cast on 15 sts.

1st Row. Knit.

2nd Row. Purl.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as

st-st (stocking stitch).

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until snood measures approximately 92cm, (36¼in), or until

nearly 2 balls of yarn have been used leaving enough yarn to cast off and ending with a ws row.
Cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Join centre back seam. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
