## SIRDAR

## 2 BALL SNOOD in SIRDAR ALPINE

## MEASUREMENTS

Snood width and length approximately

| $18 \times 92$ | cm |
| :--- | ---: |
| $7 \times 36 \frac{1}{4}$ | in |

## MATERIALS

Snood
F227 Alpine shade 402

50 g balls

The yarn amounts are based on average requirements when specified tension and yarn is used. You will also need 1 Pair of 10 mm (UK000 - USA15) Knitting Needles for the Snood.

## TENSION

17 sts and 24 rows to 20 cm , ( 8 in ) on 10 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension. Check your tension - if less stitches use a thinner needle, if more use a thicker needle.

## ABBREVIATIONS

alt alternate, $\mathbf{e m}$ centimetres, cont continue, $\mathbf{g}$ grammes, in inch(es), $\mathbf{k}$ knit, mm millimetres, p purl, rem remain(ing), rs right side, $\boldsymbol{s t}(\mathbf{s})$ stitch(es), tog together, ws wrong side.

## SNOOD

Using 10mm needles and thumb method cast on 15 sts.
1st Row. Knit.
2nd Row. Purl.
These 2 rows will now be referred to as st-st (stocking stitch).
Working in st-st (throughout) cont until snood measures approximately $92 \mathrm{~cm},(361 / 4 i n)$, or until
nearly 2 balls of yarn have been used leaving enough yarn to cast off and ending with a ws row.
Cast off.

## TO MAKE UP

Join centre back seam. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
