

2 BALL SNOOD in SIRDAR ALPINE

MEASUREMENTS

Snood width and length approximately 18 x 92 cm 7 x 361/4 in

MATERIALS

Snood

F227 Alpine shade 402 2 50g balls

The yarn amounts are based on average requirements when specified tension and yarn is used. You will also need 1 Pair of 10mm (UK000 – USA15) Knitting Needles for the Snood.

TENSION

17 sts and 24 rows to 20cm, (8in) on 10mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension. Check your tension – if less stitches use a thinner needle, if more use a thicker needle.

ABBREVIATIONS

alt alternate, cm centimetres, cont continue, g grammes, in inch(es), k knit, mm millimetres, p purl, rem remain(ing), rs right side, st(s) stitch(es), tog together, ws wrong side.

SNOOD

Using 10mm needles and thumb method cast on 15 sts

1st Row. Knit.

2nd Row. Purl.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as

st-st (stocking stitch).

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until snood measures approximately 92cm, (361/4in), or until

nearly 2 balls of yarn have been used leaving enough yarn to cast off and ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Join centre back seam. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
